Joint HKCPIE/MRCP(UK) Part II Practical Assessment of Clinical Examination Skills (PACES) October 2026

The Joint HKCPIE/MRCP(UK) Part II Practical Assessment of Clinical Examination Skills (PACES) will be held in Hong Kong from **Monday, 26 October to Saturday, 31 October 2026**. We would like to draw your attention to the following:

1 Eligibility

Applicants for PACES must have passed MRCP(UK) Part I Examination within 7 years, or have exemption from it, and should have at least 12 months of Basic Physician Training in the acute general medical wards in accredited training centers before the PACES (defined by the end of the month of this PACES diet, i.e. 31 October 2026). Applicants who do not meet this requirement at the time of application (normally 3–4 months before the examination) will need to have endorsement by their Chiefs of Service or Programme Directors to prove their eligibility. It is also recommended that candidates have commenced 18 months of Basic Physician Training before attempting PACES. Since the MRCP(UK) Central Office has a new policy on the number of attempts for MRCP examinations, please refer to the enclosed document for information.

2 Quota and Application procedures

All intending applicants should complete the enclosed “Application for PACES - Supplementary Information” sheet that **must reach the College Secretariat on or before 5:00 pm on 29 June 2026, the local closing date for new and re-entries. The College will reject applications that reach the Secretariat after the deadline.**

The quota of candidates in this PACES diet is 90. Should the number of applicants exceed the quota, priority would be given according to the following:

- (i) registered trainees of our College
- (ii) applicants who were not selected in the immediate last PACES diet
- (iii) applicants who re-sit PACES
- (iv) applicants who have passed MRCP Part II (Written) examination (priority will be given to candidates with longer BPT period)
- (v) applicants who have passed MRCP(UK) Part I examination only
- (vi) applicants who have less than 18 months of Basic Physician Training
- (vii) applicants with low score (≤ 110) at the immediate past PACES diet will be given a low priority irrespective of the other priority criteria
